KEY CHALLENGES:

- An increasing number of documents to archive.
- Protection of sensitive information from unauthorized access.





THE SOLUTION

27 mobile bases COMPATTA ^{Light} have been installed to archive hanging files developing a total of 1,600 linear meters of archive capacity.

The **shelving is equipped with removable drawers** to store documents in several types of hanging files. The files are easily accessible from above.
